## GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SECTION 9 (Horse & Ring) CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

 Refer General Conditions of Entry & Competition IN SEPARATE HANDBOOK, available at Centre Ring office, and at <u>www.qcas.net.au</u> Competitors must be familiar and understand Competition Rules and Regulations.

2. Compulsory Horse health declarations & Indemnity waiver forms MUST be completed, signed & handed to Jumbo Office in Centre Ring on arrival. Please ensure to also complete details of any Horse not competing - but are on showgrounds.

#### 3. Entrance to ring events via Ash Street

4. Nominations -Enter on the day - entry cards available all day from centre ring office on both Thursday & Friday from 8.00 am to 4.30 pm & must be paid for at time of obtaining cards.

5. Please ensure that **both top & bottom sections** of entry cards are filled out CLEARLY & CORRECTLY. Cards to be handed to Gate Steward on entry into Ring.

**6**. At the discretion of the Chief Steward/Ring Master, competitors who are improperly dressed may be refused permission to take part in the competition.

#### **GENERAL:**

**7.** Ribbons and prize money will be awarded at the Judge's discretion notwithstanding that there may be provision in the schedule for the awarding of ribbons.

8. JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.

**9.** The Chief Steward /Ring Master SHALL HAVE THE FINAL SAY IN ALL DECISIONS REGARDING ANY EVENT within the program, including entrance into events.

**10**. All Competitors in ring events must enter immediately when called upon by ring stewards. Under no circumstances will events be held up for late rider.

<u>11 .In case of 3 entries or less in a class, 1<sup>st</sup> place only will be awarded at</u> <u>THIS Show; if the merit of the 2nd exhibit in any class is not sufficient</u> <u>enough to enable them to a prize.</u>

 Unless otherwise stated only animals entered in the Stud Book – English / American/ Australian - will be allowed to compete in Led Classes. All Exhibits in Led classes to be led into the ring.

- 13. All forms of cruel, inhumane or abusive treatment of horses, which include, but are not limited to various forms of rapping, will not be tolerated and will be<sup>4</sup> dealt with severely by the Ring Committee, as they think fit.
  - **14.** The Show Society may carry out random tests for drugs in horses.

# Note: JUMPING TO BE CONDUCTED UNDER CURRENT EA NATIONAL JUMPING RULES.

- Program & course can be altered at Ring Masters Discretion.
- No Entry Cards accepted once Event starts eg. 1st horse to judge
- "H.C. to be at Ring Masters Discretion"
- "Competitors taking part do so at own risk"
- Scratchings will only be accepted under Ring Masters Discretion.

#### PLEASE NOTE : GRADING POINTS

Once a horse gains the determined number of points to jump at a higher grade and subsequently jumps at that higher grade under **NO** circumstances is that horse able to drop back to its former grade irrespective of **ANY** subsequent changes to the horse's current point tally.

ie: should your horse at an event receive 4 points that would take your horse over the 40 point requirement to jump B grade and the horse subsequently jumps at that level either at that or another competition then under no circumstances can you drop back to C grade event if an alteration occurs to the horse's points tally that would reduce the tally back to less than 40 points.

#### CARDS MUST BE PRESENTED TO COLLECT PRIZE MONEY

#### SHOW JUMPING -

- **1.** All Riders, horses and horse owners that are show jumping in Ring 1, must be members of EA. except in Junior events
- 2. Dress, Headgear & Salute is as per EA regulations.
- **3.** It is the responsibility of competitors to present performance cards before the first jumping event and collect same after final jumping competition.
- **4.** Courses may be raised or lowered/shortened at the discretion of the stewards in charge
- 5. HC : Permission is entirely at the discretion of the organising committee & the Judge has been informed that permission has been given.
- **6.** A horse competing in an event HC, is not allowed to compete subsequently for prizes on that day at that event in the same ring.
- 7. Show Jump ring to be conducted under CURRNET official EA rules.
- **8.** The AGE of all horses to be at least 4 yrs of age as at 1st of August at time of competition.
- **9.** Horses 5yrs & below are NOT permitted to compete in any competition with a starting height of 1.25m & above in the first round or Futurity classes.
- **10. AGE for Junior riders is** from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12yrs, until the end of the calendar year they reach the age of 18.
- 11. Junior classes are special events that do not count for points.
- 12. <u>One horse is restricted to three starts per day at this show / at the descretion of the chief steward.</u>
- 13. Approved safety helmets to be worn at all times while in the show ring area:- AS /NZ 3838, EN1384, ASTNF 1163, also we recommend that competitors also wear back protectors.

Bio Security for INNISFAIL Show

**"Working Together for Animal Health" -** In order to protect the welfare of animals attending the 2019 Show the following procedures are in place to ensure the safety of both our Competitors and their horses:

A veterinarian will be on call during the event

A method of making emergency phone calls or alternative communication

- A plan to minimise public access to stable areas
- Designation of an isolation area for sick horses
- Encouraging good hygiene practice between horses for officials/stewards
- Identification of horses
- Do not share equipment, including food and water containers, between horses. Avoid use of communal water troughs.

# The Innisfail Show Association makes the following recommendations for all competitors:

Primary responsibility for biosecurity at horse events lies with the horse owners/competitors, long before the event.

- Practice good biosecurity, good hygiene and decontamination of equipment.
- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand wipes and waterless hand hygiene solution immediately after handling horses.
- Do not knowingly take sick horses to an event.
- If a horse is unwell at an event, notify an event official.
- Stop all non-essential contact with the sick horse and blood or body fluids from the horse until a veterinarian has excluded Hendra virus infection as the cause of illness.
- Do not allow children to have close contact with a sick horse, at least until infection has been ruled out by a veterinarian.
- Promptly isolate sick horses and seek veterinary advice. Also isolate any equipment that has come in contact with the sick horse.

**It is important that each person intending on bringing a horse** to this upcoming competition fills out the Horse Health Declaration Form ( Pre Movement Biosecurity Form) and return it to the Innisfail Show Association centre ring before competing

Innisfail and District Show Society strongly recommend all horse owners to vaccinate as we head towards the peak winter risk period for Hendra. Vaccination is the best way to reduce the risk of Hendra infection. Sadly, human infection and deaths have occurred from high-level exposure to body fluids from infected horses. By vaccinating, owners aren't just protecting their horses, they're also protecting themselves, their family and employees.
