GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SECTION 10 (Beef Cattle)

ENTRY FEE: Entry fee will be \$5.50 per class and must be paid when nominating.

ENTRIES CLOSE AND EXHIBITS DUE:

Entries close Monday, 4th July, 2022

All Exhibitors must complete an entry form.

All cattle exhibits must be penned by 5.00pm Wednesday 6th July, 2022

JUDGING: Judging of Beef Cattle will commence at 9.30am on Thursday 7th July, 2022

PRIZE MONEY:

Presentation of trophies will take place before the sale at approx 3.45pm on Thursday, 7th July, 2022.

Trophies must be collected from the Secretary's Office, during office hours by Friday, 15th July, 2022 by 2.30pm.

Prize Money will be posted out after the Show by Cheque OR Direct Debit

(Prize money quoted does not include GST and assumes entry is a hobby. Any entrant whose entry is part of their business will need to quote their business name and ABN. If GST is applicable, we will gross up the prize so entrant is not disadvantaged. Failure to quote an ABN (for business) will result in the deduction of PAYG withholding tax of 48.5%).

CATTLE AUCTION:

A Show Sale will be held and organized by Elders commencing at 4.00pm on Thursday 7th July, 2022

The Sale is conducted on a \$ per head basis. The live weights that are displayed are for judging purposes only.

EXHIBITS COLLECTION:

All cattle must remain on the grounds until 10.00pm on Friday 8th July, 2022.



GUIDELINES FOR BEEF CATTLE

- All intending exhibitors must immediately contact Elders or the Chief Show Steward to arrange for mouthing and ear tagging of exhibits.
- The following are the colours denoting ear tagging for age:-
 - 2 teeth – orange (previously white)
 - 4 teeth – blue (remains the same)
 - 6 teeth – yellow (remains the same)
 - 8 teeth – green (remains the same)
 - Milk tooth – white (previous orange)
- Cattle will be judged for early maturity, breeding, quality, conformation, weight evenness and depth of flesh, coupled with least waste and consideration will be given to suitability to the domestic or export trade. The emphasis shall be laid on the young early maturity animal.

- Any exhibit in pen classes will be eligible for Championships.
- In the event of the Judge deciding that exhibits in any class are not worthy of a prize, no prize will be awarded.
- To enable the necessary yard accommodation to be prepared, each exhibitor of Prime Cattle must, when forwarding entries, state on the entry form the total number of cattle he/she will be sending to the Show.
- The Judges decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding his decision.
- All entries are received subject to the right of the Stewards to reject any cattle not up to Show standard and, if required, to arrange for same to be removed from the ground before Judging commences.
- All beef Cattle in the Cassowary Coast Regional Shire will have free transport to the Showgrounds.
- All beef Cattle will be fed by Stewards, Pro-rata deductions will be made by Elders.
- All sale cattle may be reclassified at the Stewards discretion.
- All Prime Cattle to be dehorned or polled.
- All beef cattle are to go to auction.
- All exhibits are entered for competition.
- All Cattle will be required to have N.I.L.S. devices applied to the off ear prior to delivery to the showgrounds.

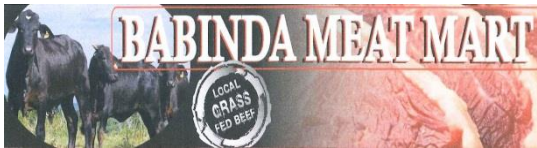

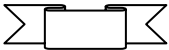

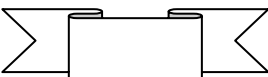

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THIS SECTION

This show is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the Innisfail and District Show Society Inc.

Intending exhibitors are advised to read the Schedule carefully and to be sure to enter exhibits into correct Classes.

HOW TO ENTER EXHIBITS:

Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date as shown in the various schedules.

Entry Forms can be obtained from the Secretary (or as included in the Schedule) and the whole of the questions asked in them must be answered as correctly as possible. Entry forms must be signed by the Exhibitor (or authorised agent), and accompanied by the amount of entry fee necessary.

No free passes are available to exhibitors, unless otherwise stated.

COLLECTION OF PRIZE MONEY:

All prizes awarded at the Show shall be payable within 14 days. Prize money required to be collected from the Secretary's Office must be collected within one (1) week after the Show finishes, otherwise it will be forfeited to the Society.

PRIZE MONEY

GST will be added to the Prize Money for Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.

The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes.
