HOW TO ENTER

1. **Fully complete the official entry form**
2. Entries will not be accepted over the phone or **AFTER** the closing date ⁴
3. Deliver **ENTRY FORMS AND FEES** in person to Secretary's Office or mail to:

4. Exhibitors will receive Entry and Class Cards
5. **Exhibits must be delivered to the designated area by the due time and date shown**
6. **All entries must be presented fully mounted and ready for hanging with class cards attached.**
7. **Any image that is NOT ready to be hung will be REJECTED.**

MOUNTING AND PRESENTATION OF YOUR PHOTOS FORM AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE JUDGING

SPECIAL REGULATIONS –

1. Each entrant is restricted to **10** entries in total
2. Prize winning prints from previous Innisfail Show entries are not eligible.
3. ALL prints:-
 - Are to be mounted on **heavy cardboard or foam core board**
 - **No other mounting material is acceptable**
 - Photos **MUST** be attached to mounting board using double sided or hinging tape or glue for foam core board. Photo corners are **NOT** acceptable. Professional mounting services may be used.
 - **Overall entry thickness must be minimum 1mm and maximum 5mm**
 - May be double mounted, i.e. attaching a framing card over the photograph that is fixed to a heavy cardboard back, but overall thickness should not exceed 5mm
 - Are required to have adhesive Velcro tabs/dots placed on the four corners of the back of the mounting board. **THIS MUST BE THE HOOK SIDE OF THE VELCRO** to enable photos to be displayed on the wall
4. **The size of photos** submitted must be:-
 - **Maximum overall size of print, including mounting materials is 35.5cm x 28cm (14" x 11").**
 - **Minimum overall size of mounting materials is 25cmx 20cm (10" x 8") with a **minimum photo image size** of 15cm x 20 cm (6" x 8")**
 -

- **Panorama prints** will be accepted in **OPEN, SCAPES** and **CREATIVE** Classes
 - The maximum photo image size of panorama prints including mounting materials is 41cm x 20cm (16" x 8") 5
 - The minimum photo image size of panorama prints including mounting materials is 30cm x 15cm (12" x 6")
 - Panorama prints would ideally be in **2:1 aspect ratio**, providing the print size is within the maximum and minimum sizes stated above.
5. ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE:-
- **Adhesive Velcro tabs/dots** on the **4 back corners** of the photo
 - **Entry/Class Card** supplied by Innisfail Show Society must be attached to the **mounting material so that it hangs below the mounting material. The class and entry number details must be clearly visible from the front on the bottom right corner**
 - You must write the following details on the back of the mounting material of each entry
 - a. Photographers Name
 - b. Entry Number
 - c. Class Entered
 - d. Title of Print Image
6. The same image cannot be entered into more than one class.
7. All exhibits are to be delivered to Pavilion 2, Photograph Section, **12pm – 6pm Friday 5TH July, 2024. The Show office will NOT accept delivery of exhibits.** (except posted entries)
8. All exhibits must be the original and unaided work of the entrant, however, commercial processing is accepted in all classes.
9. Images must NOT have NAMES, DATES OR ANY OTHER IDENTIFYING INFORMATION displayed on the image.
10. Entries that **DO NOT COMPLY** with above regulations **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR EXHIBITED. NO REFUNDS OF ENTRY FEES.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY DIVERSE ABILITIES

- **Open to people with all kinds of impairment from birth or acquired through illness or accident. It includes cognitive impairment as well as physical, sensory, and psycho-social disability.**
- **All work must have been executed by the Exhibitor and must be the original work of the Exhibitor in concept and execution.**

PLEASE READ DEFINITIONS CAREFULLY

1. Pets/Animals

Includes birds, reptiles, fish and farm animals as well as domesticated animals (pets)

1 DA. Pets/Animals Diverse abilities class

2. Landscape/Seascape

Landscapes depict natural features of the terrain, including lakes, waterways and land based cloud features

Seascapes can be water panoramas, wave studies or coastal vistas combining shoreline features. **Minimal people and man made objects.**

2 DA. Landscape/Seascape Diverse abilities class

3 Nature (Photographs of **untamed animals** and **uncultivated plants** in a **Natural Habitat**. Evidence of Man, his manipulation or environment in any part of the picture is undesirable and should be avoided. (These photographs can be entered in either Class 1 or Class 6)

4 Table Top/ and Still Life e.g. Table-Top – A scene set up in miniature on a table, and Still-Life – A vase of flowers or a bowl of fruit etc. (Photographs of jewellery, statuettes, any small articles that can be photographed on a table)

5 Floral - Can be fresh, cut, dried or pressed and can be of one or many flowers.

6 Open – Any subject treated pictorially

7 People – Portraits and Human Interest

8. Photography for Youth - This section applies only to youths (up to 16 years of age) Postcard and Larger prints are accepted

8DA. Photography for Youth Diverse abilities class

9 Digitally Altered/Creative - Photographs that have been digitally manipulated Or **ALTERED** from the original for creative effects. This includes images modified using HDR (High Dynamic Range) processing techniques

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This show is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the Innisfail and District Show Society Inc.

Intending exhibitors are advised to read the Schedule carefully and to be sure to enter exhibits into correct Classes.

HOW TO ENTER EXHIBITS:

Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date as shown in the various schedules.

Entry Forms can be obtained from the Secretary (or as included in the Schedule) and the whole of the questions asked in them must be answered as correctly as possible. Entry forms must be signed by the Exhibitor (or authorised agent), and accompanied by the amount of entry fee necessary.

No free passes are available to exhibitors, unless otherwise stated.

COLLECTION OF PRIZE MONEY:

All prizes awarded at the Show shall be payable within 14 days. Prize money required to be collected from the Secretary's Office must be collected within one (1) week after the Show finishes, otherwise it will be forfeited to the Society.
