## **GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SECTION 10 (Beef Cattle)**

**ENTRY FEE:** Entry fee will be \$5.50 per class and must be paid when nominating.

### **ENTRIES CLOSE AND EXHIBITS DUE:**

Entries close Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

All Exhibitors must complete an entry form.

All cattle exhibits must be penned by 5.00pm Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

**JUDGING:** Judging of Beef Cattle will commence at 9.30am on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

### **PRIZE MONEY:**

Presentation of trophies will take place before the sale at approx 3.45pm on Thursday, 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.

Trophies must be collected from the Secretary's Office, during office hours by Friday, 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 by 2.30pm.

**Prize Money** will be posted out after the Show by Cheque OR Direct Deposit

*(Prize money quoted does not include GST and assumes entry is a hobby. Any entrant whose entry is part of their business will need to quote their business name and ABN. If GST is applicable, we will gross up the prize so entrant is not disadvantaged. Failure to quote an ABN (for business) will result in the deduction of PAYG withholding tax of 48.5%).*

### **CATTLE AUCTION:**

A Show Sale will be held and organized by Qld Rural commencing at 4.00pm on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2025

The Sale is conducted on a \$ per head basis. The live weights that are displayed are for judging purposes only.

### **EXHIBITS COLLECTION:**

All cattle must remain on the grounds until 10.00pm on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.



## **GUIDELINES FOR BEEF CATTLE**

- All intending exhibitors must immediately contact QLD Rural or the Chief Show Steward to arrange for mouthring and ear tagging of exhibits.
- The following are the colours denoting ear tagging for age:-
- 2 teeth – Red
- 4 teeth – blue
- 6 teeth – yellow
- 8 teeth – green
- Milk tooth – white

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- Cattle will be judged for early maturity, breeding, quality, conformation, weight 4 evenness and depth of flesh, coupled with least waste and consideration will be given to suitability to the domestic or export trade. The emphasis shall be laid on the young early maturity animal.
- Any exhibit in pen classes will be eligible for Championships.
- In the event of the Judge deciding that exhibits in any class are not worthy of a prize, no prize will be awarded.
- To enable the necessary yard accommodation to be prepared, each exhibitor of Prime Cattle must, when forwarding entries, state on the entry form the total number of cattle he/she will be sending to the Show.
- The Judges decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding his decision.
- All entries are received subject to the right of the Stewards to reject any cattle not up to Show standard and, if required, to arrange for same to be removed from the ground before Judging commences.
- .All beef Cattle will be fed by Stewards, Pro-rata deductions will be made by QLD Rural.
- All sale cattle may be reclassified at the Stewards discretion.
- All Prime Cattle to be dehorned or polled.
- All beef cattle are to go to auction.
- All exhibits are entered for competition.
- All Cattle will be required to have N.I.L.S. devices applied to the off ear prior to delivery to the showgrounds.
- All Veterinarian fees are the responsibility of the Owner of the animal. Innisfail Show will not take responsibility for any veterinarian fees.




