- Entries in any other variety classes will not be accepted unless the variety is stated on the entry form.
- Where there are three (3) or more exhibits of the one breed in any other variety classes, a special class will be provided.
- The Society accepts no responsibility for loss, damage, or misdelivery of exhibits.
- No person other than the Judge or Steward will be allowed to handle birds for the duration of the Show without the of the Chief Steward.
- No Birds to be sold in Pavilion during the Show without permission of Chief Steward
- Number of Entries by each exhibitor in all classes is limited to four (4).
- Cockerels and pullets shall be birds of 12 months and under.
- Birds will be fed, watered and cared for during the period that they are in the care of the Show Society.

- Where there are three or more entries in the same variety in A.O.V. classes, a class will be provided.
- For Class 140 (Any variety school child pet bird), any clean bird cage is allowed.
- Entries in A.O.V. or A.O.C. will only be accepted where variety or colour is clearly stated on the Entry Form.

The Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. GENERAL RULES FOR POULTRY AND CAGED BIRDS

- The Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. General Rules for the Conduct of Agricultural Show
- Competitions must be adhered to.
- 2. All Birds are to be free of lice, Stick Fast Fleas and disease.
- 3. Exhibitors are not to talk to Judges during judging.


- 4. Stewards can steward classes in which they have entered.
- 5. Birds 12 months and over will be judged as adults.
- 6. Should any dispute arise for which there is no general rule the matter in dispute will be referred to the committee and their decision will be final.
- 7. Birds can only be removed from showing area with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 8. Any Bird entered in the incorrect class can, at the discretion of the Chief Steward, be re-entered in the correct class.
- 9. Any Bird found to have been tampered with may, at the discretion of the Stewards and Committee, be disqualified.
- 10. All animal/s and bird/s exhibitors must sign an Exhibit Health Declaration upon delivery of entry and must comply with the health requirements detailed in this document.




