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WASTE TO ART- SECTION 8

Waste to Art Competition – Turning Waste into Creative Expression

Introduction

With growing national and international concerns about waste management and environmental sustainability, there is an urgent need to change our perception of waste from a nuisance to a valuable resource. A Waste to Art competition offers an engaging and educational platform for community members, schools, and local organisations to creatively transform waste into meaningful artworks.

The Cassowary Coast Regional Council has launched kerbside recycling in March 2025, presenting the ideal moment to introduce a creative competition highlighting waste minimisation, recycling, and the circular economy.

Objectives

- **Promote awareness of waste management:** Educate the community about the impact waste has on the environment. Highlight the environmental benefits of recycling, reducing landfill, and the broader importance of sustainable waste practices.
- **Encourage creativity and innovation:** Inspire participants to discover new, artistic, and innovative ways to utilise everyday waste items, promoting creative thinking and imaginative solutions to waste reduction.
- **Highlight the value of the waste economy:** Demonstrate how waste materials, traditionally seen as useless, can be transformed into valuable, functional, or aesthetically pleasing items, supporting the principles of a circular economy.

Materials Allowed:

- Clean cardboard
- Aluminium cans
- Rigid plastics
- Glass bottles and jars
- Any other items suitable for the yellow bin

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Materials Not Allowed:

- Soft plastics
- Textiles
- Food-contaminated containers
- Items unsuitable for the yellow bin

REGULATIONS FOR WASTE TO ART EXHIBITORS:
(Please read carefully)

A. ENTRY FEE: Free entry! No cost to participate. Please ensure you fill out all particulars on the Art Entry Form which includes:

- a) Title
- b) Medium and Support
- c) Size and Display Method
- d) Artist Statement (see below)

B. ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries close with the Secretary of the Innisfail and District Show Society Inc on **Tuesday, 8th July 2025 at 5.00pm.**
No late entries will be accepted.

C. EXHIBITS DUE: Exhibits must be delivered to the Pavilion No.2, between **9.00am - 12.00pm on Wednesday 9th July 2025.** If you cannot make these times, please contact Show Secretary to make alternative arrangements.

D. EXHIBITS - LABELLING ON BACK

Each artwork must be clearly marked on the back with the following information:

('Labels' for back of artwork now provided for use - see middle of schedule book)

1. a) Exhibitor's Name b) Address c) Telephone Contact No.
2. Section 8 & Class No.
3. Title of Work, Month/Year completed.
4. a) Materials used (must align with yellow bin guidelines)
b) Size of Artwork **plus Framed outer size** if applicable.
5. Display method (Easel / Tabletop / Hanging)
6. For Youth entrants: Date of Birth must be included.

E. EXHIBITS - LABELLING ON FRONT:

Each artwork must display their Exhibit Entry Label (*best placed bottom right hand front corner*) and be clearly marked as follows:

1. Class No. Entry No. plus 'artwork title' if preferred. Exhibit Entry Labels are **provided by Show Secretary** once entry form is received.

Note: All details must be the same as on the Entry Form.

Those not so marked will not be hung.

F. JUDGING: (*Closed to the Public*)

Judging takes place **Thursday 11th, from 9.00am to 12 noon.**

Judging will be conducted by **Cr Jeff Baines** and **Cr Trudy**

Tschui. A separate **People's Choice Award** will be determined by public QR code voting.

G. PRIZE MONEY: Excellent prizes to be won, including cash and gift cards, **plus the potential for a special community-led prize for the People's Choice winner.** Prize Winners are requested to present their cards for payment of prize money at the Show Secretary's Office **by Friday 18th July, 2025**

H. EXHIBITS COLLECTION: **All Waste To Art Exhibits must only be collected from Pavilion No.2 between 9.00am and 11.00am on Saturday 12th July 2025..** The Exhibitor must sign these out or by a nominated authorised person with a letter informing such by the Exhibitor.

RULES FOR ART EXHIBITS:

(Please read carefully)

1. Open to all members of the public – individuals, schools, groups.
Age categories:
 - Children under 5
 - Ages 6–12
 - Ages 13–18
 - Open category
2. All artworks must be made from recycled materials. This is a great way to learn what can and cannot be recycled.
3. Entries must be created within the past 12 months.
4. One entry per person or group is permitted. Group submissions are welcome.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR WASTE TO ART

5. **Materials must comply with yellow-lidded recycling bin rules:**
 - Allowed: Clean cardboard, aluminium cans, rigid plastics, glass bottles and jars
 - Not allowed: Soft plastics, food-contaminated items, textiles, or any non-yellow bin material
6. **Presentation:** Specify clearly how the work should be displayed:
 - Hanging (must be fitted with D-rings and wire)
 - Tabletop display
 - Easel (bring your own or request one)
7. All entries must be suitable for public display – sturdy, clean, and safe.
8. **Artist Statement is required**, explaining:
 - Materials used and their recycling suitability
 - Creative intention or message of the work

OTHER CONDITIONS

- Artworks not meeting presentation or safety standards may be excluded.
- If entries exceed display capacity, a selection process may be used.
- By entering, you agree your artwork may be used in promotional content.
- Insurance is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

JUDGING CRITERIA

1. **Creativity and innovation** – effective use of recycled materials; originality
2. **Recycling message** – clear alignment with yellow bin rules and awareness
3. **Artistic quality** – execution, composition, and overall visual impact
4. **Display and finish** – suitable for hanging or presentation, robust and clean

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GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THIS SECTION

This show is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the Innisfail and District Show Society Inc.

For particulars regarding Entry Fees, dates of closing of entries, dates and times for delivery of exhibits and special conditions relating to particular Sections, refer to the relevant Section notes in this Schedule. Intending exhibitors are advised to read the Schedule carefully and to be sure to enter exhibits into correct Classes.

HOW TO ENTER EXHIBITS:

Entries will not be accepted over the phone or after the closing date as shown in the various schedules. Entry Forms can be obtained from the Secretary (or as included in the Schedule) and the whole of the questions asked in them must be answered as correctly as possible. Entry forms must be signed by the Exhibitor (or authorised agent), and accompanied by the amount of entry fee necessary.

No free passes are available to exhibitors, unless otherwise stated.

COLLECTION OF PRIZE MONEY:

All prizes awarded at the Show shall be payable within 14 days. Prize money required to be collected from the Secretary's Office must be collected within one (1) week after the Show finishes, otherwise it will be forfeited to the Society.

RULES FOR SHOW SOCIETIES, STEWARDS, JUDGES, EXHIBITORS AND

PRIZE MONEY

The Association will provide a "Recipient Created Tax Invoice" to Exhibitors who are registered for GST purposes. No art union, raffle or game of chance will be allowed without the approval of the Committee.
