## RING EVENTS RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- All Entries must be made in the name of the owner of the Horse.
- Awards: Ribbons, Trophies and Prize Money as per Program.
- Note: It is intended to run events in strict program sequence. • Marshalling areas will be provided and all competitors in the events following the current one being judged must be marshalled five minutes prior to the commencement of the event. Any competitor not in attendance at the marshalling area, at the time other competitors enter the ring, will be disqualified. • All Horses to be measured must be in attendance at the measuring bay at 8am on the day of competition. Measure cards from previous shows 2026 will be accepted, but must be available at all times.
- Stallions are banned from Hack Events.
- Any Horse on the ground can be subject to swabbing.
- Any dog or animal not restrained or acting in a manner to cause nuisance to the public or other campers will be removed from the grounds without notice by officers of the Cassowary Coast Regional Council
- All Exhibits must be Bona Fide Property of the Exhibitor at the commencement of the Innisfail Show. (A lease constitutes Bona Fide ownership)
- Horses appearing in the ring for judging wearing ribbons, medals or prizes awarded in previous classes will be disqualified.
- Ridden Pony Classes available for adult and junior riders.
- All ridden classes are open to both show horses and hunters.
  - Competitors nominated in two rings where a time clash occurs must make a choice in which ring to compete. Approval to hold up a ring will be at the discretion of stewards.
- All Horses and other livestock, where practical, shall be paraded as directed by the Ring Steward. Exhibitors who do not comply may be fined at the discretion of the Stewards and the Show Society may retain any prize money won. The decision of the Ring Steward is final.
- No person except those actually engaged in charge of exhibits and the Stewards and Officials shall be permitted to remain in the ring during Judging.
- The Judge may, at his/her discretion, refuse to award a prize where an exhibit is deemed by him/her to be not of sufficient merit. The Judge's decision in this respect will be final and conclusive.
- The Judge may transfer exhibits entering the wrong class to the proper class.
- The Ring Steward reserves the right to alter, amend, or abandon all or portion of the Ring Program.
- Show Jumping to be judged under EA, FEI Rules and to be jumped over such obstacles as the Judge directs.

- Any Horse may be eliminated at the discretion of the Judge or Steward.
- All Stallions in led classes to be led with a bar or chain and adequately strong headstall.
- Nomination Fee must be paid for before entering Ring.
- **LATE NOMINATIONS and class changes may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee. Any Late Nominations will incur a late fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.**
- Excessive and unnecessary punishment of horses in the Ring or outside may lead to disqualification for the balance of the Show.
- Sorry no Refunds.
- Sponsored Riders – Please Note that no banners or signs can be displayed away from Trucks. Only Saddlcloth Logos and Horse Prefixes can be used in the Ring.
- All Fees and Charges are inclusive of GST. GST will be paid on Prize Money to those who have an ABN and are GST Registered. • All Competitors must fill out all required forms before any entries will be taken.
- Portable panels or temporary fencing is allowed in the designated camping area.
- **YARDS – A limited number of yards are available this year. Competitors are asked to be considerate when booking, so we can accommodate as many horses as possible. Cost \$20.00 per yard, per night. Yards must be booked online. Yards must be left clean and free of manure.**
- DEFINITIONS:
  - Local – If the Innisfail Show Holiday is your public holiday.
  - Smartest on Parade - judged on presentation of horse and rider and overall appeal and elegance as a combination.
  - Maiden - has not won a Maiden Class at an affiliated show.
  - Novice - has not won a champion at an affiliated show.
  - Consolation - has not won a ribbon today.
