**ENTRY FEE:** \$5.00 per entry for Classes **1 to 12**

**\*\*Free Entry** for Classes **13 to 23** (Special Needs & Junior Classes)

**ENTRIES CLOSE AND EXHIBITS DUE:** All entries close at 4.00pm on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2026

- Items can be entered and Section Card collected at the Secretary's Office prior to the closing date, and the **Exhibits (with section card) are to be taken to No.1 Pavilion** on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July or Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July between 1.00pm and 5.00pm, or **can be left at the Innisfail Woodworker Guild**
- **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**

**JUDGING:** Judging of Woodwork to commence at 9.00am, Wednesday, 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2026

**PRIZE MONEY:** As stated in Classes throughout the Schedule.

**Prize Cards & Prize money must be collected from the WOODWORKERS GUILD Office between Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July and Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> July 2026.**

*(Prize money quoted does not include GST and assumes entry is a hobby. Any entrant whose entry is part of their business will need to quote their business name and ABN. If GST is applicable, we will gross up the prize so entrant is not disadvantaged. Failure to quote an ABN (for business) will result in the deduction of PAYG withholding tax of 48.5%).*

### **EXHIBITS COLLECTION:**

- Entries may be collected (post Show) on Saturday, 11<sup>th</sup> July 2026 between 9.00am and 11.30am at the exhibit area, or collected from the **WOODWORKERS GUILD** Office, or by prior arrangement.

*This show is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies and the Innisfail and District Show Society Inc.*

*For particulars regarding Entry Fees, dates of closing of entries, dates and times for delivery of exhibits and special conditions relating to particular Sections, refer to the relevant Section notes in this Schedule. Intending exhibitors are advised to read the Schedule carefully and to be sure to enter exhibits into correct Classes.*

### **GUIDELINES FOR WOODWORK EXHIBITS:**

The Innisfail & District Show Society will not under any circumstances hold itself responsible for loss, and/or misdelivery of any exhibit, and also, reserve the right to refuse any exhibit for any reason whatsoever.

Sale of exhibits must have the Selling Price clearly marked on the entry form and back of the Exhibit. 10% of the marked price is to be paid to the Innisfail & District Show Society.

**Novice Entries:** Exhibitors are eligible to enter as a novice provided they have not won a First prize in that section previously.

**Intermediate Entries:** – **JUNIORS ONLY SECTIONS.** Exhibitors are eligible to enter as an intermediate provided they have won a first prize in Novice and have not won a First prize In Open

**Open Entries:** Exhibitors are eligible to enter as an open provided they have won a First prize in Novice or Intermediate and or Open

*These conditions apply to the exhibitor, not the item being judged.*

Each exhibitor can have many entries as long as they are in the correct section Exhibits must be made by the exhibitor in the last 12 months

A minimum of three (3) separate exhibitors is necessary to constitute a Section. If there is less than three (3) Exhibitors in any section, the items entered will be dealt with separately at the discretion of the Stewards.


